Halls seating over 800 may require amplification with a sound engineer, four microphones and four boom stands (preferably short boom stands) and two monitors.

For concert performances, the Minneapolis Guitar Quartet with Sachiko Nishiuchi “La Chayi” requires an elevated stage in a concert hall or auditorium with appropriate stage lighting and two dressing rooms/green rooms. MGQ & “La Chayi” require a space on stage at least twenty feet wide and eighteen feet deep with five straight back armless chairs (preferably padded). The MGQ requires amplification with a sound engineer, four microphones and four boom stands (preferably short boom stands), and two monitors.

For the dancer, a wood stage is preferred and the stage must be able to withstand light to moderate use with flamenco tap shoes.

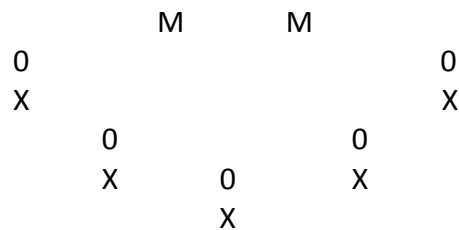
